St. Jude Children's Research Hospital®

When the late entertainer Danny Thomas opened the doors to St. Jude Children's Research Hospital® in 1962, he was not just changing the lives of those children who would walk through its doors. He was changing lives across the world. The mission of St. Jude Children's Research Hospital® is to advance cures and means of prevention for pediatric catastrophic diseases through research and treatment. Consistent with the vision of our founder Danny Thomas, no child is denied treatment based on race, religion or a family's ability to pay. St. Jude is one of JFC's original Legacy Charity partners from our inception in 1999. Since that time we have donated more than \$ 8.6 million. This support has been used to fund the bone marrow transplant unit, a chair in genetics and gene therapy, an immune system research project and beginning in 2011, a \$ 3.5 million, multi-year research project on using natural killer cells to fight rejection during bone marrow transplants.



Make-A-Wish America®

Since 1980, Make-A-Wish America® has enriched the lives of children with life-threatening medical conditions through its wish-granting work. The Foundation's mission reflects the life-changing impact that a Make-A-Wish® experience has on children, families, referral sources, donors, sponsors and entire communities. Make-A-Wish America® was founded in 1980 after a little boy named Chris Greicius realized his heartfelt wish to become a police officer. Since its humble beginnings, the organization has blossomed into a worldwide phenomenon, reaching more than 250,000 children around the world. Make-A-Wish America® is another of JFC's original Legacy Charity partners. Since our inception we have provided over \$7.8 million to support wish granting in the United States. This support has allowed more than 1,200 wishes to be granted across the country through the Wish A State program.



Elizabeth Glaser Pediatric AIDS Foundation

The Elizabeth Glaser Pediatric AIDS Foundation is a nonprofit organization dedicated to preventing pediatric HIV infection and eliminating pediatric AIDS through research, advocacy, and prevention, care, and treatment programs. Founded in 1988, the organization works in 17 countries around the world. The Elizabeth Glaser Pediatric AIDS Foundation was born from the most powerful force of all: a mother's love for her children. The Elizabeth Glaser Pediatric AIDS Foundation is the third of the original JFC Legacy Charity partners. Since 1999, we have provided more than \$ 7.8 million reaching more than 150,000 expectant mothers with transmission prevention programs and research projects that will help 100s of thousands of children.



National CASA Association

The National CASA Association is a network of more than 1,000 program offices that are recruiting, training and supporting volunteers to represent the best interests of abused and neglected children in the courtroom and other settings. The National CASA Association was added as a JFC Legacy Charity partner in 2003. Since that time, more than \$ 6.5 million has been donated to National CASA which has been used to make grants to local CASA chapters across the country to help recruit and train volunteers to represent more than 5,100 children in foster care. JFC Support has also been used to produce two Public Service Announcements for recruiting volunteers; a re-launch of the National CASA website, and disaster relief efforts in U.S. counties affected by hurricanes.
